

### Q1 Do you know that the Labour Department has recently issued a revised Code of Practice of Typhoons & Rainstorm Warnings?




### Q3 Does your organisation have any written policy / document stipulating the work arrangements for essential staff during extreme weather conditions?



# Q5 Which of the statement below best describes your organisation's arrangement on transportation for essential staff under extreme weather conditions when they have to report for duty?




## Q6 Does your organisation grant a travelling allowance to members of essential staff that have to commute to and from their workplaces under extreme weather conditions?













## Q13 How likely is it that your organisation's employees would be consulted on the review of the existing work arrangements for essential staff during extreme weather conditions?






